ARRIVAL:

- 8:30 8:55 OUTSIDE RECESS/BREAKFAST. Kindergarten to the left of the building and grades 1-4 behind the building
- 8:55 Students enter building and proceed to their classrooms
- 9:00 Student report time
- Students arriving after 9:00 will be considered tardy and must be signed in by a parent/guardian.
- Students eating breakfast should proceed directly to the cafeteria upon arrival No morning recess.

ABSENCES

Parents/guardians MUST call the office to inform the school if a child is absent. For your convenience, we have an answering machine
that will accept sick calls 24/7. An absence may also be reported through a link on our website. The student must bring a note upon
returning. Five consecutive days absent requires a note from the doctor.

DISMISSALS:

- Students must have a note from their parent/guardian for changes in their dismissal. For the safety of the students, the school will not accept any changes for dismissal over the phone during the school day.
- EARLY RELEASE TIME: 11:35 AM. Please see Haverhill Public School Calendar for early release dates.

MORNING DROP OFF:

• Student drop off is along the sidewalk on the right. This is a moving line, no parking. If you need to enter the building, please park in the parking lot.

AFTER SCHOOL PICK UP:

Parent pick up is 3:15. The pickup line is a moving line that does not begin until this time.
